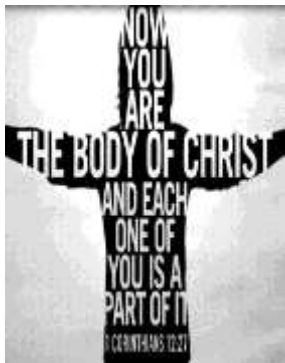

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ



The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is also known as the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, which translates from Latin to "Body of Christ." This feast calls us to focus on two manifestations of the Body of Christ – the Holy Eucharist and the Church.

The primary purpose is to focus our attention on the Eucharist. At every Mass our attention is called to the Eucharist and the Real Presence of Christ in it. The opening prayer at Mass calls our attention to Jesus' suffering and death and our worship of Him, especially in the Eucharist. The second focus of this feast is that of the Body of Christ as it is present in the Church. The Church is called the Body of Christ because of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with his disciples. He expresses this in the gospels by using the metaphor of a body in which He is the head. This image helps keep in focus both the unity and the diversity of the Church.

This Feast, also known as Corpus Christi, is an opportunity for public Eucharistic processions held in some areas – such as the ones held in our parish many years ago with hundreds of parishioners singing and praying as they processed around the church. These processions serve as a sign of common faith and adoration.

Our worship of Jesus in His Body and Blood calls us to offer to God our Father a pledge of undivided love and an offering of ourselves to the service of others.

Reflection: Do we properly prepare to receive the Eucharist and fully realize the true meaning of the Real Presence of Christ that we receive? How do we, as members of the Body of Christ, the local Church, respond to the call to be of service to others?
