## SCHEDULE AND FEES

Students may register for as many as 4 classes (one each hour).  
Students may not have an open period between classes and remain on campus unless attended by an adult.

### LET'S EXPLORE THE FUTURE: VOCATIONS

Gr. K-3, 4-7

## ARRIVALS AND STUDENT DROP-OFF

Students may arrive as early as 7:45 am if they are registered for an 8:00 am class.

Parents may drop-off students in the designated areas or park and walk them in to the gym area. There will be student helpers to escort students to the gym.

Students will find their class signs in the cafeteria and line up there until their teacher arrives to take them to class. No students are allowed to go to their class without the teacher.

## DEPARTURES AND STUDENT PICK-UP

Students should be picked up by 12:00 pm.

Parents may drive through the pick-up line or walk in to meet their child.

## DAILY PROCEDURES

On the first day, a student will pick up a name badge that will have all of his classes listed. He should wear the name badge everyday so that we may assist him in finding his classes.

Each day when a student arrives on campus he will find his class sign in the cafeteria and line up there until his teacher arrives to take him to class. No student may go directly to the classroom.

Students will be taken back to the cafeteria when the class is over to find their next class sign and to meet their teacher. Students will always be returned to the cafeteria after a class unless it is time for them to be picked up.
